



Case Study Fylingdales Parish Council Robin Hood's Bay

Fylingdales Parish is set in a beautiful corner of the North Yorkshire Moors National Park, including Robin Hood's Bay, Fylingthorpe village and surrounding areas. When worn out seating needed to be replaced Fylingdales Parish Council chose Marmax Products to supply recycled plastic benches. The Parish Council has to consider the needs of large numbers of tourists as well as the local population. Lanchester Seats have been placed at the top of the bank at Robin Hood's Bay, overlooking the spectacular costal scenery, whilst Traditional Seats and a picnic bench have been used in the playground in Fylingthorpe village. Other benches have been sited next to bus stops and at viewpoints throughout the Parish, providing a welcome resting place to enjoy the wonderful country and coastal views.
